Baptism stands between the sinner and salvation—(Mark 16:16) “He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and remission—(Acts 2:38) “Repent ye, and be baptized every one of you for the remission of sins.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and the washing away of sins—(Acts 22:16) “Arise and be baptized and wash away thy sins.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and rejoicing—(Acts 8:39) “And when they were come up out of the water ...he went on his way rejoicing.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and calling on the name of the Lord—(Acts 22:16) “Arise and be baptized ...calling on the name of the Lord.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and the death of Christ—(Romans 6:3) “Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into His death?”

Baptism stands between the sinner and the blood of Christ—(Romans 6:4) “Therefore we are buried with Him by baptism into death.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and getting into Christ—(Romans 6:3) “Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and the resurrection—(Colossians 2:12) “Buried with Him in baptism, wherein we are risen with Him.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and the new life—(Romans 6:4) “Even so we also should walk in newness of life.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and putting on Christ—(Galatians 3:27) “For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and the cleansing—(Ephesians 5:26) “That He might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the Word.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and sanctification—(Ephesians 5:26) “That He might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the Word.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and justification—(1 Corinthians 6:11) “And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and becoming a new creature—(2 Corinthians 5:17) “Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and the one body—(1 Corinthians 12:13) “For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and receiving the blessing of the Holy Spirit—(1 Corinthians 12:13) “For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body ...and have been all made to drink into one Spirit” (Acts 2:38).

Baptism stands between the sinner and regeneration—(Titus 3:5) “Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, by the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Ghost.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and entrance into the Kingdom of God (John 3:3-5) Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, “Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.”

Baptism stands between the sinner and a relationship with the Father, Son and Holy Spirit—(Matthew 28:19) “Baptizing them...into the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
