What The Bible Actually Says

Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ...To Timothy, my dearly beloved son (2 Timothy 1:1-2 I besought thee to abide still at Ephesus, when I went into Macedonia, that thou mightiest charge some that they teach no other doctrine (1 Timothy 1:3). I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions and giving of thanks, be made for all men; for kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty (1 Timothy 2:1-2). Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all. Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them; for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself and them that hear thee (1 Timothy 4:15-16).

But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry (2 Timothy 4:5). For bodily exercise profiteth little; but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come (1 Timothy 4:8). These things write I unto thee, hoping to come unto thee shortly; But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth (1 Timothy 3:14-15).

Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity. Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine (1 Timothy 4:12-13). But shun profane and vain babblings; for they will increase unto more ungodliness. And their word will eat as doth a canker; of whom is Hymenaeus and Philetus; Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already and overthrow the faith of some (2 Timothy 2:16-18).

Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth (2 Timothy 2:15). But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them (2 Timothy 3:14). Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honor, especially they who labor in the word and doctrine (1 Timothy 5:17).

I charge thee therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ—Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine (2 Timothy 4:1-3). In all things shewing thyself a pattern of good works; in doctrine shewing un-corruptness, gravity, sincerity, sound speech, that cannot be condemned; that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you (Titus 2:7-8). These things speak and exhort and rebuke with all authority. Let no man despise thee (Titus 2:15).

Holding fast the faithful word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers. For there are many unruly and vain talkers and deceivers, specially they of the circumcision; Whose mouth must be stopped, who subvert whole houses, teaching things which they ought not, for filthy lucre's sake (Titus 1:9-11). A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject (Titus 3:10). Lay hands suddenly on no man, neither be partaker of other men's sins; keep thyself pure (1 Timothy 5:22).

O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings and oppositions of science falsely so called (1 Timothy 6:20). And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also. (2 Timothy 2:2)

Life-Changing Experiences

What are some phrases that you never want to hear? "It's cancer"; "There's nothing we can do", He didn't make it"; there's been an accident at work"; "You're fired"; "We're downsizing"; "We've decided to make a change"; "I'm leaving"; "I don't love you anymore"; "I have found somebody else"; "You are under arrest". Each of these phrases can bring chills, tears and despair. Once you have heard one of these, there will be change taking place. These phrases tell of death, divorce, loss of job, loss of reputation and loss of love.

They can also serve as benchmarks of change in someone's life for good or bad. We see that some, when these situations happen, turn away from God and some turn to God—the same situations but different outcomes.

When we look at the life of David there were many of these phrases he heard. He had to hear that his mentor, Saul, wanted him killed; his baby from a sinful relationship with Bathsheba was sick and had died; that his children committed horrible sins and one even wanted to kill him; and he was told that he was guilty of murder by a prophet of God. When these things happened, David turned to God. He referred to God as his refuge in 2 Samuel 22:3; "My God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold and my refuge." There are over 40 references to God as a refuge in the Psalms. A refuge is a place of shelter, safety and hope. And we all at times need a refuge. We can see that God was David's refuge and He also should be ours. David shares some wonderful news with us in 2 Samuel 22:31. "As for God, His way is blameless: The word of the LORD IS TESTED; He is a shield to all who take refuge in Him." This tells us that God is willing to be our refuge.

When we encounter those "life-changing moments" let us, like David, turn to God as our refuge and allow Him to be our place of shelter, safety and hope.
